Approval – Dangerous Goods Training Course

1 Application

This instrument applies to Contract Aircrew Training Ltd [ARN 751637] (the **company**), the training course materials submitted to CASA (the **training courses**) and persons who undertake the training course (the **employees**).

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 November 2020; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of October 2023

3 Approval

The **training course** is approved as being appropriate for regulation:

- a) 92.095 – Training – certain employees of Australian aircraft operators (Group B, Group C or Group D employees);
- b) 92.100 – Training – certain employees of Australian ground handling agents, (Group B or Group C employees);
- c) 92.105 – Training – certain employees of Australian freight forwarders, (Group B employees);
- d) Employees with a combination of responsibilities for Group B, Group C, or Group D employees.

4 Conditions

- a) Changes to the Civil Aviation Act 1988, the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998, the International Civil Aviation Organization - Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air, and the International Air Transport Association - Dangerous Goods Regulations, in force from time to time, must be reflected, as applicable, in the course material and CASA must be notified in writing of the changes made.
- b) Where any course is limited to certain DG Class/Hazard Divisions, then those workbooks, promotional material and certificates of training are to reflect those limitations.
- c) The company is required to retain training records of the training courses, employees and instructors for a minimum period of 36 months from the most recent training completion month and must be made available upon request to the employee or CASA.
- d) This approval is subject to a satisfactory standard being maintained in accordance with the relevant requirements of regulation 92.135.
- e) CASA may revoke this approval if it is necessary in the interests of the safety of air navigation.
- f) The Instrument number may be abbreviated as CASA.DGTNG.0152-1

5 Repeal

All previous versions of this Instrument are hereby repealed on 1 November 2020.
